Theme and Science

Learning at Home

- ✓ Your child to read to you.
 Children should be reading up to 4 times a week at home.
- ✓ Practice their spellings.

 Spelling tests will be every week. Children will also have speed reader challenges to help them become more fluent with their reading.
- ✓ Practice times tables. Children should be able to quick fire their times tables and begin to know some division facts,
- Ask your children what they have done today at school. This is a fantastic opportunity for your child to share their experiences with you as well as practicing their communication skills.
