Things to do at home

Please could you support your child with practising putting their coats and shoes on independently if they aren't doing so already.

Please encourage your children to count, read books and practice name writing at home- this really helps their learning in Nursery.

If you weren't able to attend a parents meeting for your child last half term, please speak to your child's keyworker to discuss the possibility of meeting to discuss your child's progress.

Please ensure your child has the following items every day.

- Full school uniform everyday (With names written in each item)
- Spare clothes on their peg (underwear, Trousers and t-shirt).
- A pair of wellies (Your child will be outside during all types of weather).
- If your child uses nappies please ensure you bring nappies, wipes and nappy sacks- **Please support your children in becoming toilet trained. If you would like any support with this please ask.**
- As the weather is getting warmer, you will need to apply sun cream on a morning and please send your child to school with a sun hat and/or sunglasses.
