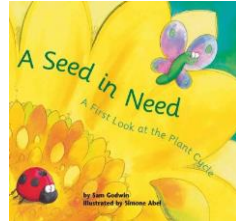
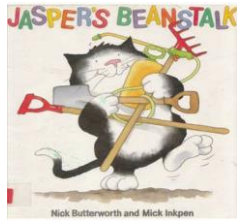
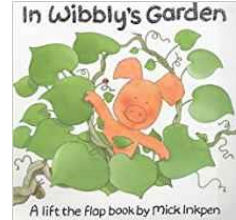


# Harehills Primary School Parent's Newsletter

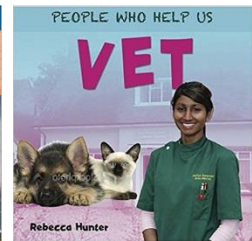
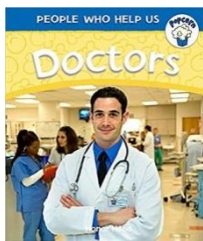

**You can help your child at home by** identifying patterns and shapes within the environment and modelling how to count everyday objects slowly and carefully.
