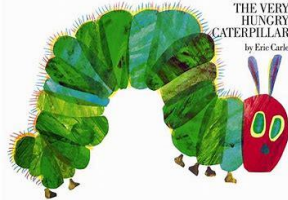
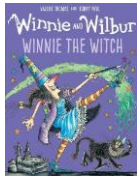


Harehills Primary School Parent's Newsletter

Our Topics... This half term we will be focusing on "growth and minibeasts". The children will be planting seeds and learning about how to look after things that grow in a garden. They will also be learning about minibeasts through stories such as "The Very Hungry Caterpillar".



After the holidays we're going to be looking at "Tricks, Wishes and Wonders". We will be sharing stories about witches, fairies, dragons, giants and much more. The children will be using their imagination to create wonderful stories about these magical creatures.

In Literacy we will be learning:

This term we will be focusing on consolidating all our Phase 2 and Phase 3 phonics, as well as introducing the children to Phase 4 phonics.

In Literacy we will be encouraging the children to write sentences and very simple stories. We will also be reading a range of new and exciting books.



In Maths we will be learning:

We will be teaching the children to add and take away number up to 20. We will be focusing on teen numbers in our lessons where the children will be, adding, doubling, sharing ordering and halving the numbers to 20.

We will also be looking at 3D shapes and positions, as well as talking about weight, distance and money.

Please encourage your children to use their number knowledge to help you at home.
