

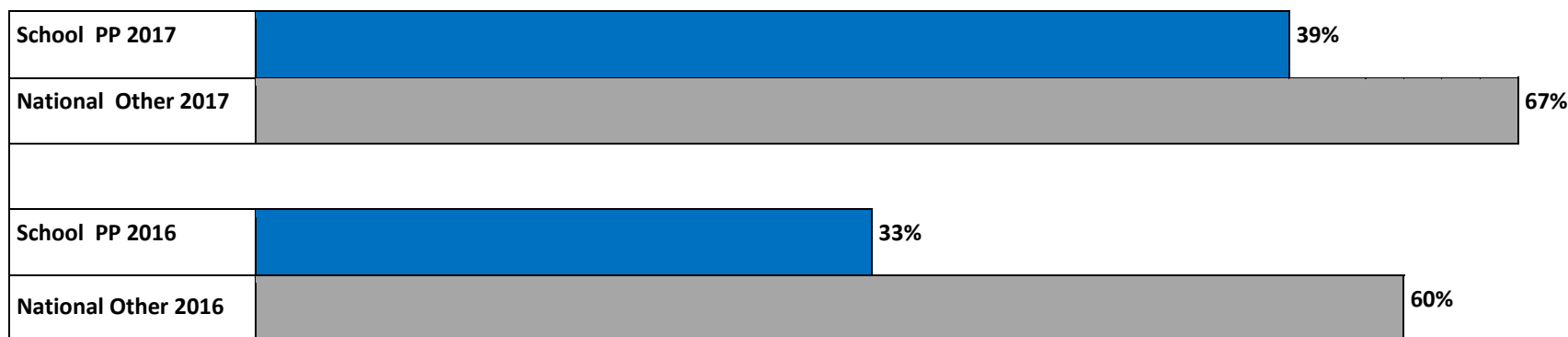

Key Stage 2 Pupil Premium Attainment

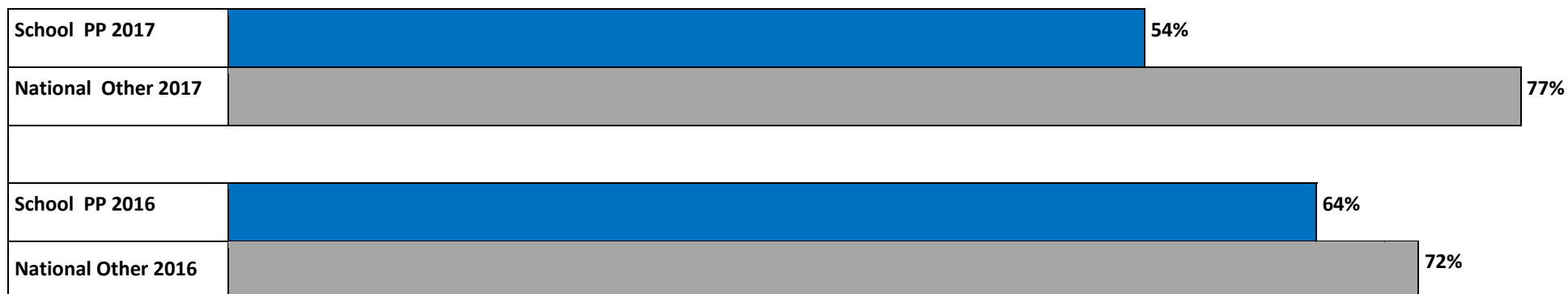
Key stage 2 national curriculum test outcomes for reading and mathematics report whether pupils are working at the EXPECTED STANDARD. Writing and science are not tested, and so Teacher Assessment (TA) report whether pupils are working at the EXPECTED STANDARD for these subjects.

The following performance information includes **41** Pupil Premium Funded pupils in the school and is compared with that of 'National Other' (all non-disadvantage pupils *Nationally*)

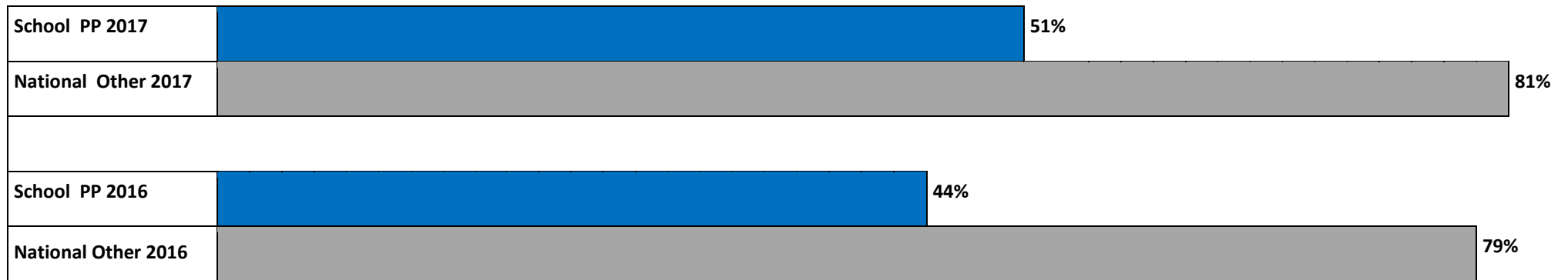
Year 6 pupils achieving at least EXPECTED standard in **Reading, Writing & Mathematics combined**



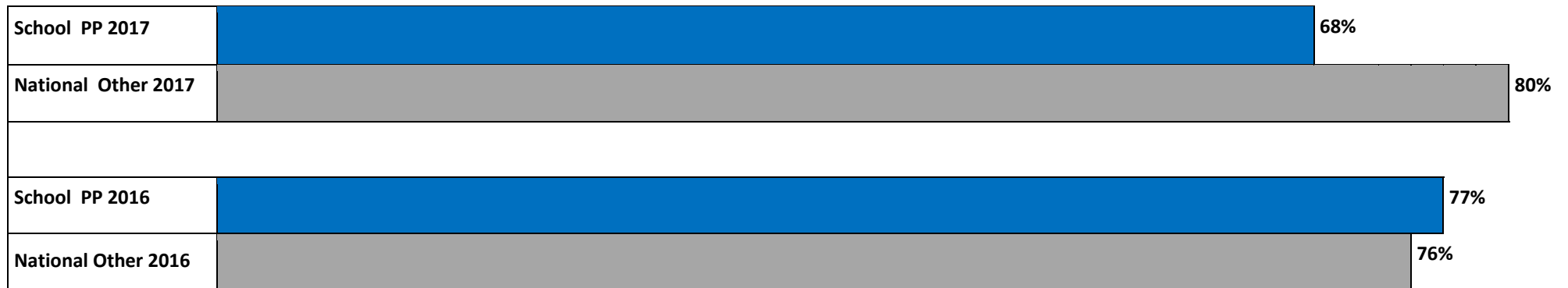
Year 6 pupils achieving at least EXPECTED standard in **Reading**



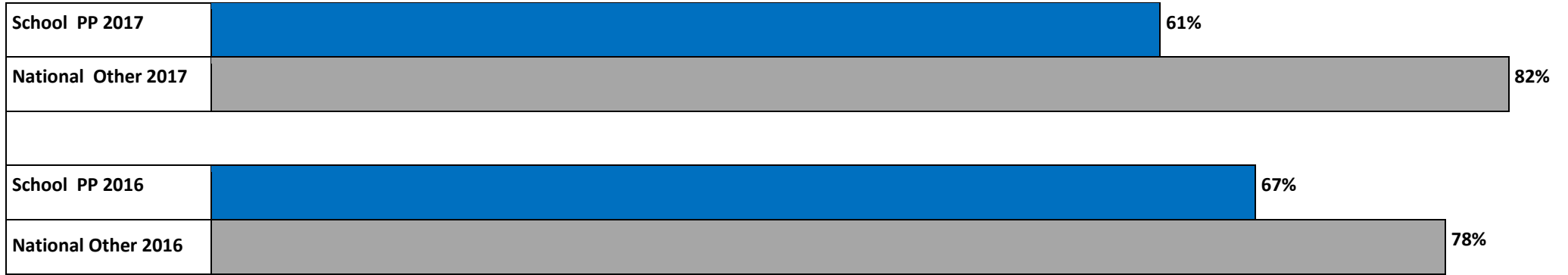
Year 6 pupils achieving at least EXPECTED standard in [Writing](#)

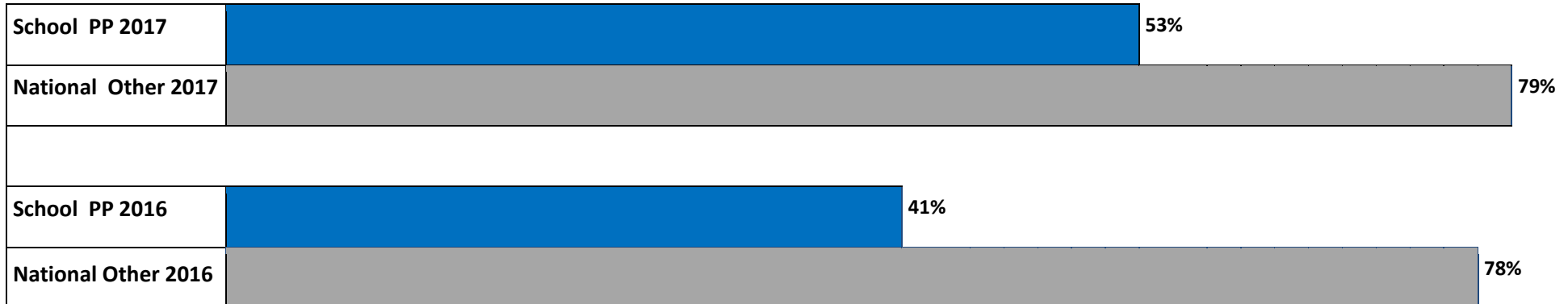

Key Stage 1 Pupil Premium Attainment

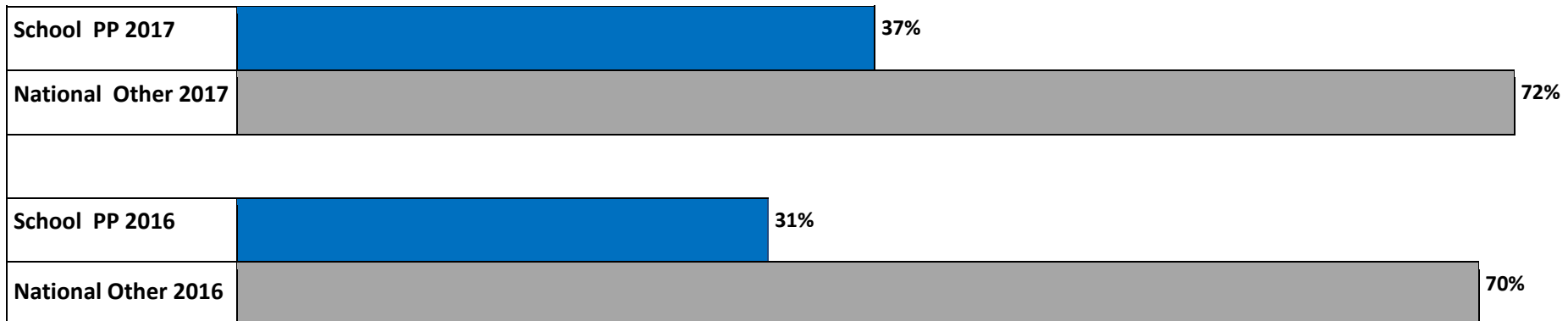
At key stage 1, teacher assessment is used for reading, writing, mathematics and science to report whether a pupils has achieved the EXPECTED STANDARD. To support teacher assessment, key stage 1 staff deliver tests (SATs) to pupils in May.

Below is the performance of 19 Pupil Premium Funded pupils in the school and is compared with that of 'National Other' (all non-disadvantage pupils *Nationally*)

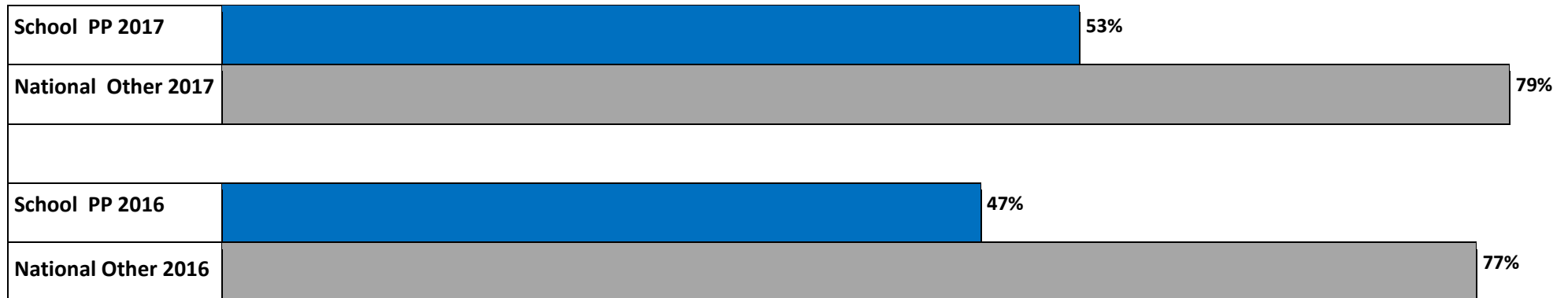
Year 2 pupils achieving at least EXPECTED standard in Reading



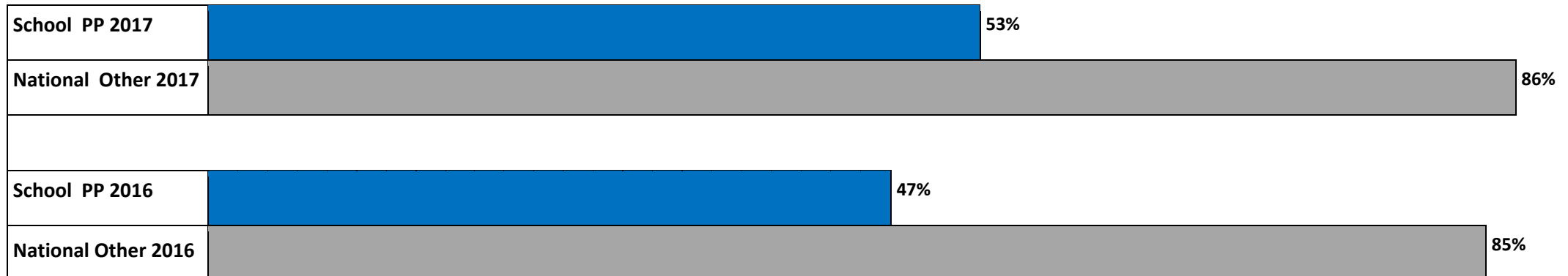
Year 2 pupils achieving at least EXPECTED standard in Writing



Year 2 pupils achieving at least EXPECTED standard in [Mathematics](#)









Year 2 pupils achieving at least EXPECTED standard in **Science**
